



# **2022 Highlights**



- **Provided 6,095 youth with employment opportunities** and enriching educational experiences via county-funded and business-funded partnerships.
- Introduced the *Alsobrooks Summer Passport Experience* to the SYEP youth.
- **Hired 37 young adults** through the Talent Pipeline Program to serve in critical roles with various County Agencies.

## County Agencies 2022 Program Successes

**Office of Community Relations** – An intern was able to shadow the Associate Deputy Director for a day and viewed the County Executive's press conference.

**Police Department** – As of result of officers sharing information about their divisions, one intern applied for a job with the Prince George's Police Department Cadet Program.

**Office of the County Executive –** Over 1000 participants participated in the Alsobrooks Summer Passport Experience program.







## Nonprofit Organizations 2022 Program Successes

**DC Flight Club Aviation Program** – In addition to exploring various careers in the field of aviation from FAA professionals, participants were allowed the opportunity to fly a single-engine aircraft during the program's DC Flight Club Fly Day.

**National Energy Education Development** (NEED) **Project** – Participants obtained handson STEM experience focused on energy conservation and education.

**Prince George's Community College** – Offered industry-based training with certifications in the following areas: HVAC, information technology, automotive, and medical billing.

**Prince George's County Public Schools** – Provided over 400 positions to participants in administration, human resources, technology, and beautification.

# **Strategic Direction**

SYEP will continue to utilize the following strategies:

- **Simple Application** The application will continue to be simple enough for the youth applicants to complete independently.
- Customized Programming Applications will continue to be prepared for youth ages 14 and 15, 16 and 17, and 18 through 22 to allow them to apply for programs and job opportunities specific to their age group and preferences.
- **Delivery Options** Experiences will be provided with virtual, in-person, and hybrid delivery options.
- Youth@Work Internship Program (Formerly Talent Pipeline Program/TPP) These opportunities are designed to employ young adults ages 18 through 22 into County positions beyond the 6-week summer period based on the County's need and/or the participant's demonstrated performance.




